



2019 Rugby World Cup in Japan!



14th to 25th September 2019

Join our special tour, visiting some of the most iconic locations in the country, joining the excitement of being part of the Rugby World Cup 2019.

The intention is to form a choir for the trip (either male, female or mixed) and to perform at 1 or possibly 2 concerts during the visit. **If there are not enough choristers, the trip will go ahead without the concerts.**

Day 1 (14 September) Join a British Airways direct flight to Tokyo from London (T5 Heathrow). [Other airlines available].



Day 2 Morning arrival in Tokyo where we will be met and transferred to our centrally located hotel for a 4-night stay.

Day 3 Today we include a city tour, designed to provide a great introduction and to help you get your bearings. Highlights include the Asakusa Kaman Temple, Meiji Shrine and the Imperial Palace, regarded as the heart and soul of the city. The rest of the day is free.

Day 4 We have a day at leisure in Tokyo today.

Day 5 We have an included **excursion** to Nikko where you can see Japan's most lavishly decorated shrine complex, made famous by its 'see no evil, hear no evil, speak no evil' monkey carvings.

Day 6 We depart Tokyo this morning and begin our journey to Kyoto. En route we will we will visit sacred Mount Fuji, the highest mountain in Japan and recognized as one of the most beautiful volcanoes in the world before continuing by "Shinkansen," **the bullet train**, from Odawara to Kyoto. Upon arrival in Kyoto we will transfer to our centrally located hotel for a 3-night stay.



Day 7 Today we have an included **excursion** of Nara and Kyoto, with lunch. First, we will visit Nara, where you can discover a wide selection of historic treasures, including the giant Todaiji Temple, which houses Japan's largest Buddha statue (Daibutsu).

The delightful Horyuji Temple is recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is home to the world's largest wooden building.

After an included lunch we will return to Kyoto. Hundreds of spectacular temples, stunning shrines and dreamy gardens present a near-perfect image of the old Japan. Kyoto is also home of the geisha, young girls who entertain guests through many traditional Japanese arts.

In Kyoto we will visit the truly impressive Nijo Castle, residence of the Tokugawa shogun, and the magical Kinkakuji Temple, known as the Golden Pavilion as it is covered in gold leaf.

Day 8 Today we included our **excursion** to Hiroshima and the island of Miyajima. Learn about the tragic events of 6th August 1945, and see the Torii Gate, the symbol of Japan, rising from the sea.



Day 9 Today we will transfer to Osaka for a half-day sightseeing tour, visiting wonderful attractions such as Osaka Castle, Minami shopping area and the floating garden observatory. Three nights in Osaka.

Day 10 (September 23) Today **we transfer to Toyota City to watch Wales play Georgia** (match ticket provided) in one of the first World Cup qualifying rounds. Return to Osaka after the match.

Day 11: Last full day at leisure in Osaka.

Day 12: Sadly, we say farewell and transfer out to the airport for the overnight flight back to London.

Day 13: Arrive UK. Tour Ends.

The Tour is open to all travelers from the UK. The music content will depend on how many choristers sign up to tour. Should there not be enough singers to form a viable choir, the tour music content will be of a less formal nature.

Tour Price: £4,400 per person sharing a twin or double room. Single room available on request.

Included: Coach transport to and from Heathrow from designated pick-up points, Return Airfare, Excellent Hotels on B/B, All transfers while on tour, Excursions as per itinerary, Tour Guides and Match Ticket (optional).

Arrangements can be made for anyone wishing to extend their visit at the end of the tour to watch other World Cup matches.
